My dear Appleton,

You may be aware that we set up an Atomic Research Board sometime back under the chairmanship of Prof. H.S. Saha, I.I.T. The Board has undertaken work for some time on the measurement of tracks in photographic emulsions. I understand that Messrs. Cook, Troughton & Sims have developed a new type of microscope for observing tracks in emulsions. This firm had been approached for supplying one microscope by the Physical Research Laboratory, Ahmedabad and it appears that they booked an order for this Laboratory but later regretted their inability to supply the same before 3 or 4 years. We are now badly in need of 2 or 3 of these newly developed microscopes, one for the Physical Research Laboratory, Ahmedabad, and the other for the Atomic Research Board. Since the firm state that they are unable to supply these microscopes for some time owing to pressure of home orders, I would request you to kindly see if anything could be done in this matter. It would help us considerably if you could make an approach to the proper authorities on our behalf for getting.....
