Seminar Chaired by AJK President on 'Creation of Pakistan: 'Quaid's decision is validated by Hindutva policy of Modi

President of Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK), Sultan Mehmood Chaudhary, and Federal Minister for National Food and Security, Syed Fakhar Imam, a seminar chaired on Kashmir organized by Jammu Kashmir Self Determination Movement, International. The event was also attended by numerous Members of Parliaments (MPs) of the United Kingdom, Pakistan's parliamentarians and civil rights activists.

Federal minister Fakhar Imam reiterated that the decision of Quaid-i-Azam to create Pakistan has once again been validated by the Hindutva policy of Indian Prime Minister (PM), Narendra Modi with regard to Kashmir.

He said that PM Modi is trying to change the demographics of Kashmir and stressed that India's ethos has completely changed under Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangham ideology (RSS) the Modi government. Fakhar said that the world has started to open its eyes to the human rights violations in Kashmir, which have been highlighted by international media such as the New York Times, the Washington Post, and The Wall Street Journal, etc.

He echoed that the United Nations (UN) has discussed the issue of

Kashmir numerous times including the developments in the aftermath of 5th August 2019, which proves that Kashmir is a disputed territory. Fakhar said that the emerging strategic partnership between America, Japan, Australia, and India has allowed India to expand its hegemonic designs in the region. He stressed that PM, Imran Khan has raised the plight of the Kashmiris on every forum and his party will continue to expose India as an oppressor and aggressor denying the Kashmiris their right to selfdetermination. Fakhar further said that India has the highest civilian to the military ratio (9:1) in Kashmir to suppress their freedom.

PM of AJK held meeting with top officials of Pakistan: Urged International Community to provide safety protocol to Journalists

The Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) Prime Minister (PM), Sardar Abdul Qayyum Niazi in his meeting with the chairman of the Parliamentary Kashmir Committee, Shehryar Afridi among have appealed to the others international community to play their role in stopping the genocide of the Kashmiris by the Indian forces in occupied Kashmir. Addressing the 30th meeting parliamentary of the committee on Kashmir, AJK PM drew the attention of the international community towards the deteriorating situation in occupied Kashmir and called for providing protections to the journalists. Kashmiri While

appreciating the role of journalists in occupied Kashmir, despite a ban, he noted that the liberation of occupied Kashmir and the development of AJK will be the top priorities of his government.

AJK PM further appreciated the Kashmir Premier League (KPL) and Pakistan cricket Board for organizing an international event in AJK which helped in promoting tourism and generating economic activities in the state.

The Chairman of the Parliamentary Kashmir Committee, Shehryar Afridi who presided over the meeting said that India has failed to crush the freedom movement with the use of military force and now has imposed restrictions on the media to suppress the popular voice of the Kashmiri people. He regretted that international human rights organizations are not taking action against the Indian government and even not playing their role in stopping the genocide of the Kashmiri people.

The spokesman of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Asim Iftikhar briefed the participants about the steps taken by the foreign ministry in projecting the Kashmir issue at the international arena. He further noted that the death of Syed Ali Geelani and the harassment of his family by the Indian occupation authorities will also be raised at the international level.

Major Agrarian Development projects launched in AJK with the financial support of the Pakistan Government

The National Projects Coordinator (NPC) of Pakistan, Muhammad Tahir Anwar meet the Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) secretary of agriculture and irrigation, Muhammad Bashir Butt, and discussed the progress of various ongoing developmental projects. PM Imran Khan emphasized to setting up 3 tourist cities in GB to promote Tourism

Prime Minister (PM), Imran Khan in his discussion with the Chief Minister (CM) of Gilgit Baltistan (GB), Khalid Khurshid emphasized establishment of 3 tourist cities in GB. PM Imran Khan reiterated that the government has already important steps to promote tourism. As a part of the plan, PM Imran Khan wants one tourist city in each of the three divisions of GB. CM of GB assured PM that practical steps are likely to be taken soon to identify places provide facilities for establishment of such tourist cities.

CM Khalid Khurshid informed PM that initially, Skardu city will be developed for tourism. He noted that Skardu will be developed as a planned city, which will include hotels, motels, and rooms that will be prepared for the accommodation keeping in view the needs of the tourists. He noted that giving Skardu Airport the status of an international airport is also one of his initiatives.

In this regard, recently, the Director of Air Transport has issued a letter to the Aviation Division regarding Skardu Airport. In which it was said that Skardu Airport is being given the status of an international airport. It was decided that to achieve this Skardu has to be connected to the routes of international flights in Pakistan. With initiative, the arrival international flights will also boost tourism and increase foreign exchange under which Skardu Airport may also be available for designated foreign airlines. According to a Pakistan International Airlines spokesperson, in light of the vision of the PM of Pakistan and the directives of the Minister of Aviation, International Pakistan Airlines (PIA) has significantly increased flights to the northern regions. The spokesman said that on July 24, for the first time in the history of the GB, six flights from Islamabad, Karachi, Lahore, Sialkot, and Faisalabad arrived at Skardu Airport and six departed.

'Pakistan should hand over Kashmir to the Taliban'

After the death of Syed Ali Shah Geelani, the Taliban sent a strong message to the world, conveying that wherever Muslims are oppressed, the Taliban will help Muslims in every possible way, not just morally. In this regard, former Ambassador of Pakistan Abdul Basit was asked if there has been a change in Pakistan's Kashmir policy which is having a positive impact on the international community. He said that due to Indian lobbying and conspiracy, the Kashmiris

independence movement have been thwarted. He further opined that our failure in Kashmir diplomacy has been due to our fear and lack of a strong policy.

It means what Pakistani diplomats are exaggeration; doing, is individual events is exaggerating failure of diplomacy. Diplomacy is a continuous process, not a recurrence of an event. The whole world is silent on what happened after the death of Syed Ali Geelani. This is a great proof of Pakistan's diplomatic failure. Pakistan had set up some important institutions focused on Kashmir in the Western countries in 1990, which have not only been cut off from financial support but have been completely shut down. Though, over the years, Pakistan has given a new direction to its Kashmir policy at the diplomatic level to convey position to the international community. This includes presenting evidence of Indian aggression in Kashmir and hiring reputed political experts to support the peaceful struggle of Kashmiris. But what has been achieved so far?

After 9/11, Pakistan stopped supporting the armed movement to avoid allegations of terrorism. But despite all this, India has not yet responded positively to Pakistan's Even, offer. under the Shimla Agreement, India has promised to resolve issues through dialogue. Geelani, the great Hurriyat leader, was the representative of Pakistan in Kashmir. Even when gun was pointed at him he used the slogan 'We are Pakistanis, Pakistan is ours'. Syed Ali Geelani was the voice of Pakistan in Kashmir, who spent the last 12 years of his life in the captivity of a brutal enemy.

He spent the last few months in critical condition, being forcibly detained by the Indian government at a time when he needed intensive care. That is why the death of Mr. Geelani is also being blamed on the Indian government who is accused of murdering him. This is because he was deliberately kept away from medical facilities. Thanks to the late Syed Ali Geelani, today, at a time when Indian- Kashmir has become the largest prison in the world, the spirit of freedom is alive and well. independence movement in Jammu and Kashmir has been going on for the last 70 years and lately, Pakistan's diplomatic activities are proving somewhat fruitful and many Western countries are beginning to support Pakistan's position. But such initiatives does not mean freedom of Kashmir. More than 100 countries around the world continue to criticize India's decision to confiscate Kashmir's internal sovereignty on August 5, 2019, by removing Articles 370 and 35A. India has stifled its constitution and its democracy. India's action cannot be challenged in any court, because in the era of Modi, the spirit of the Indian judiciary also seems to be wounded. The rise of religious fanaticism and the ongoing human rights violations in Kashmir are alarmingly bad. But Pakistan neither have close ties with nor is it doing anything India movement substantial for the Kashmir. Therefore, it is now imperative that Pakistan "hands over the task of Kashmir's independence" to the Taliban.
