'World must stop human rights violations in Indian held Kashmir'

For over seven decades, people of "Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir" (IIOJK), have struggled to realise their inalienable right to selfdetermination. This right guaranteed to them by the United Nations Security Council (UNSC), the international community, and both India and Pakistan, the parties to the Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) dispute. But India reneged on its commitment, refusing to implement the UNSC resolutions by holding an impartial plebiscite under the auspices of the UN to let the Kashmiris decide their future. India has tried to muzzle the voice of the Kashmiri people through the use of force which has increased in brutality and oppression after 5 August 2019. Often termed a nuclear flashpoint, the I&K dispute endangers regional as well as international peace and security. At the same time, its humanitarian dimensions deserve particular attention and therefore resolution of this core dispute is also key to the true potential unlocking development and regional cooperation in South Asia.

In line with Prime Minister (PM) Imran Khan's declaration to take two steps for peace if India takes one, a meeting between foreign ministers of Pakistan and India was planned on the sidelines of the UN general assembly session in September 2018 which was cancelled.

However, our peace overtures were undoubtedly "misconstrued weakness by the Bhartiya Janata Party (BJP) and Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) combine that thrives on anti-Muslim, anti-minority and anti-Pakistan rhetoric and policies." India failed to translate bravado into action when. in February 2019. misadventure across the Line Control backfired. Pakistan shot down two Indian Air Force planes and captured an Indian pilot who was later returned as a gesture of peace.

Despite BJP's dangerous record of scuttling peace, PM Imran Khan congratulated Modi on his electoral victory in May 2019 and expressed the desire to build peace in the region. India chose not to respond to that and the BIP had other ideas. They sought, illegally and unilaterally, to change the status of Indian-held Kashmir with nearly a million troops, it imposed a military siege on 8 million Kashmiris, imprisoned entire Kashmiri the political detained leadership, and thousands of Kashmiri vouth. Draconian communications laws. blackout, and denial of access to international media and observers created a climate of impunity in which systematic and gross violations of including enforced human rights disappearances and extra-judicial killings have continued unabated. All this flies in the face of UNSC resolutions and international law, particularly 4th Geneva the Convention. Ironically, "India, the perpetrator," wants a permanent seat at the UNSC.

Pakistan refuted 'baseless Indian propaganda of killing militant' along LoC

Pakistan, Foreign Office (FO) Spokesperson, Asim Iftikhar, while responding to the news circulating in the Indian media about the arrest of a Pakistan based militant and killing another near the Line of Control (LoC), said that "such allegations are the established Indian tactics mischievously implicate Pakistan and divert world attention from its heinous activities in Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK)." He asserted that Pakistan has categorically rejected the "baseless propaganda" by terming it an attempt to divert focus from the grave human rights violations in the occupied territory.

The FO spokesperson further noted Pakistan had shared "incontrovertible evidence" with the world about India's serious human violations in "occupied Kashmir", through a dossier with "concrete evidence." He stated that as a matter of fact, thousands of young Kashmiris are imprisoned in Indian jails on fabricated charges, and then they are produced before the world as "alleged militants" whenever India pressure the from international community.

The FO spokesperson further noted that Pakistan is "seriously concerned" about the recent Indian attempts to vitiate the environment in and around the LoC. Though, he stressed that Pakistan is "maintaining restraint, despite the Indian provocations," in line with the Director Generals of Military Operations' (DGMO), understanding of February 2021 regarding the ceasefire along the LoC.

'Establish Commission of Inquiry to investigate Human Rights Violations in Kashmir:' KIIR to UN

Chairman of Kashmir Institute of International Relations (KIIR), and permanent representatives of World Muslim Congress (WMC), Hussain Wani has urged the United Human **Rights** Council **Nations** (UNHRC) to intensify its efforts to establish a commission of inquiry in line with the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) recommendations investigate human rights violations in the Indian held territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

Taking part in the debate held under Item-4 during the 48th session of the human rights council in Geneva, Wani briefed the world audience about the worsening political and human rights situation in the Indian-held territory.

He further noted that 'most of the credible outlets of international media and human rights organizations, including UN have been reporting on the killings, torture, intimidation and judicial harassment against activists and journalists, and other mass human rights violation in Kashmir but the Indian government's is still uninclined to refrain from hiding its crimes.' The

KIIR chief said that, recently, the police in Jammu and Kashmir raided the homes of many Kashmiri journalists, and confiscated their phones, laptops, and Passports.

The Indian authorities, he said, have brought politically motivated criminal cases, including under broadly worded terrorism and sedition laws, against political leaders of Kashmir Including Shabir Ahmed Shah, M. Yasin Malik, Nayeem Ahmed Khan, Massrat Alam Butt, Asiya Andrabi, and others languishing in Indian Jails without trial.

The first 4G spectrum for AJK and GB auctioned for more than 30 million

The first-ever cellular spectrum auction for Next Generation Mobile Services (NGMS) in Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) and Gilgit-Baltistan (GB) has been completed, which generated revenue of \$30.5 million. Four mobile companies have participated in the spectrum auction. Telenor Pakistan Limited acquired 1.2 megahertz (MHz) in the 1800 MHz band for 1,044,000, while China Mobile Pakistan (CMPak) Telecommunication Operator, Zong acquired 1.2 MHz in the 1,800 MHz bands for 1,044,000. Similarly, Ufone, Pakistan Telecom Mobile Limited managed to get 1.2 MHz in the 1800 MHz band for 10.44 million while Telenor got 15 MHz in the 2100 MHz band for one crore 13 million.

According to Federal Minister for Information Technology Syed Aminul

Haq, successful companies will be responsible for at least 50% payment in a month. He noted that the chairman of Telecommunication the Pakistan Authority (PTA) and the entire team congratulations deserve successful conduct of the spectrum auction. The Federal Minister said that the spectrum auction will provide broadband services to 9 million customers of AJK and GB and within 6 months of the auction, consumers will get a clear difference in the speed of mobile internet. Amin-ul-Haq said that after broadband services, tourism, health, education, and business activities in the region will be relieved.
