

Sindh government announces public holiday on February 5 to observe Kashmir solidarity day

The Sindh government has declared February 5 a public holiday on the occasion of Kashmir Solidarity Day. As per the notification, all government and private offices, educational institutions and markets would remain closed on that day. The day is included in the list of gazetted holidays of the federal government every year. The Foreign Office (FO) spokesperson had said that on January 26, as India observed Republic Day, Pakistan reaffirmed its "unshakable resolve to continue to raise its voice and extend all possible right support for the of determination of the people Kashmir", who marked that day as "black day." He said that it was deplorable that in the past few days, the "Indian occupation forces had further intensified the military siege" already in place in the "occupied territory" for more than seven decades. spokesperson said that "coercing innocent Kashmiris to hoist Indian flags on Republic Day" was typical of India's arrogance to project a "false sense of normalcy" and a hopeless attempt at masking its "systematic and widespread oppression."

'India's cruel tactics cannot change the reality of Kashmir dispute:' APHC-AJK

The leaders of All Parties Hurriyat Jammu Conference "Azad Kashmir" (APHC-AJK) chapter, Sheikh Abdul Mateen and Imtiaz Wani have said that "India's cruel tactics" cannot change the reality of the Kashmir dispute. The APHC-AJK leaders paid tributes to the "five Kashmiri youth who were martyred by the Indian troops" in Pulwama and Budgam. 'Utterly delusional:' Pakistan FO rejects Indian minister's remarks regarding 'integration' of 'AJK'

The Pakistan Foreign Office (FO) spokesperson Asim Iftikhar Ahmad said that Pakistan "reject the utterly delusional and provocative" remarks by an Indian minister belonging to the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) who called for the "integration" of "Azad Jammu and Kashmir" (AJK) with India by 2024. The FO spokesperson said that political figures from the "BJP and Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh" (RSS) combined are in the habit of dragging Pakistan into India's domestic politics "in a bid to divert public attention from major issues and to stoke hypernationalism to make electoral gains." He further said that the Indian government should stop indulging in "absurd and fantasies to cognizance of the grave situation on the ground in Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir" (IIOJK)." He said that despite "decades of unabated Indian oppression and the illegal and unilateral actions" of August 5, 2019, Kashmiris' resolve to "resist Indian occupation" has only strengthened over time. He opined that Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) is an "internationally recognised dispute" on the agenda of the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) and the final disposition of J&K will be made in a free and

impartial plebiscite. He stressed that rather than entertaining any notions of "aggrandizement, India should vacate its illegal occupation of IIOJK" and be prepared for accountability for the "brutalization of the innocent Kashmiris by its occupation forces." The FO spokesperson added that Pakistan would continue to extend all possible support to the Kashmiri people in their struggle for the "right to self-determination."

'India bent on changing IIOJK into Hindu majority state:' JKNF Spokesman

The Jammu and Kashmir National Front (JKNF) spokesman Shafiq-ur-Rehman said that the "brutal killing of four Kashmiri youths by the Indian occupation forces" during a crackdown and search operations in the Naira area of Pulwama district is the "worst form of state terrorism." He further said that the "systematic killing of Kashmiri youth" was a part of the ruling "regime's dream project" that sought to "change the region's demography" from a Muslim majority region into a minority through "systematic elimination of Muslims."

He further claimed that "everyday carnage" on the streets in Kashmir, was the most obvious manifestation of "extremist nationalism", aimed at fueling an "ethnic cleansing" which posed a grave "existential threat" to Kashmiris under "India's authoritarian regime." While expressing his party's

concern over the "worsening political and human rights situation in the region", he said that it was high time that the world took cognizance of "Indian state terrorism." He also condemned the issuing of summons by police to two Kashmiri journalists and termed it as an "atrocious assault on free media and independent journalism."

'Modi's fascist policies have failed to crush Kashmiri resistance spirit:' PM Imran Khan

The Prime Minister (PM) of Pakistan, Imran Khan in his message on Kashmir solidarity day, reiterated that "Pakistan stands united with Kashmiri brothers sisters" and and urged international community to take notice of "India's crimes against humanity." The PM wrote in his Twitter handle, that, "Modi's fascist policies oppression and violence have failed to crush the spirit of the Kashmiri Indian-occupied resistance in Kashmir" (IoK). He stressed that it is time the world takes notice of "India's grave human rights violations in 'IoK', war crimes and genocidal acts as well as the threat of forced demographic change." He noted that "all these are in complete violation of the Geneva conventions," and added that it is the international community's responsibility to ensure an "impartial plebiscite in Kashmir."

He further maintained that Kashmir issue is an internationally recognized dispute in the relevant United Nations Security Council (UNSC) resolutions and stressed that the "human rights situation in 'IoK' has continued to worsen following India's illegal and unilateral actions in August 2019." He said that India has not "reciprocated for peace efforts Pakistan's stability", stressed and that the "durable peace, security and development in the region hinge on peaceful resolution of the Jammu and Kashmir dispute."

'267 meter Diamer-Bhasha Dam cableway bridge Completed'

To accelerate the transportation of heavy machinery and construction materials across the Indus River to the Diamer-Bhasha Dam Project (DBDP), the construction of a 267-meter long temporary cable bridge has been completed. According to the Pakistan Water and Power Development Authority (WAPDA), the cableway bridge can bear 80 tons of weight and

noted that before the 267-meter long cableway bridge on River Indus downstream, three cableway bridges, upstream of Main Dam, are already operational for the transportation of heavy machinery and building materials. The contract for consultancy services for the project was awarded to Diamer-Bhasha Consultants Group (DBCG). The DBCG's comprises 12 topranked national and foreign consulting including China Water firms, Beifang Resources Investigation, Design and Research (BIDR) Company. These firms have vast experience in providing consultancy services for mega water projects the world over. The DBDP is being constructed on River Indus, which is scheduled to be completed in 2028-29. The project will have a gross water storage capacity of 8.1 Million Acre-Feet (MAF) to irrigate 1.23 million acres of additional land, with an installed power generation capacity of 4,500 Mega Watt (MW), the project will provide more than 18 billion units per annum to the national

'Dasu-Raikot project of KKH to be completed in March 2022'

The north zone of the National Highway Authority (NHA) member said that the rehabilitation, improvement and widening of the existing Karakoram Highway (KKH) from Dasu to Raikot will be completed in March 2022. After completion of the 172km-long project, the KKH from Thakot to Khunjerab would become

fully functional as this was the major block to reach the China border. He said that the rehabilitation of KKH from Dasu to Raikot is a deposit work of the Water and Power Development Authority (WAPDA) and it has provided the 2.4 billion total funds for the project while NHA is executing the project on-site. project is being constructed by the Rustum Associates and Dynamic Constructors-Joint Venture (RADC-JV), which has gained a positive repute for constructing roads, especially in hard areas like Gilgit-Baltistan (GB) and "Azad Jammu and Kashmir" (AJK).

The JV has also developed three projects, funded by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) that include the Rehabilitation of Mansehra to Naran-Jalkhad-Chillas Road, Rehabilitation of National Highways Naran-Jalkhad and **Bridges** Rehabilitation of National Highways and Bridges at Naran-Jalkhad of N-15. The KKH is one of the highest paved "international roads" in the world and now the tourists could reach Gilgit-Baltistan (GB) directly by using KKH from Mansehra after leaving Hazara motorway.

'SCO brings 4G to GB's Shamshal valley'

The Special Communications Organisation (SCO) has bought 4G services to Shamshal village in Gilgit-Baltistan (GB), where people previously had to travel five hours to

Hunza for communication and medical assistance. Shamshal, a border village that connects Pakistan and China, is located 55 kilometres away from the Karakoram Highway. The SCO worked to bring "civic facilities for people of far-flung regions" of GB, as earlier, it installed Shifa telemedicine in the region, which helped connect the local community with 6,000 doctors across Pakistan to avail the medical facility at home. A Memorandum Understanding (MoU) was signed between the SCO and Zong Pakistan last year to carry out various telecom projects and activities in "Azad Jammu and Kashmir" (AJK) and GB. The MoU signing ceremony was attended by SCO director major general Shahid Siddique, Zong CEO Wang Hua, Zong Chief Technical Officer (CTO) Lu Jianhui and senior officials of SCO and Zong. According to a press release, Zong will work in collaboration with the SCO, which is the largest and most prominent telecom services provider in through its "strategic GB, AJK, activities."
