### Iran's envoy: IAEA report a regular technical document

Iran's Ambassador and Permanent Envoy to the Vienna-based International Organizations Mohammad Reza Ghaebi said on Wednesday that the latest report released by the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) on Iran's nuclear activities is an updated regular technical report. He said it is based on a report provided by Iran to the agency. The official told the press that the IAEA has already presented the result of its verification tests to member states.

According to the report, Iran has begun feeding its IR-6 centrifuges in Fordo site with hexafluoride gas to produce 20% enriched uranium and also permitted the IAEA inspectors to run their extraordinary verification tests there.

### Iran dismisses any military ties with Yemen

### Iran: IAEA Report on Iran's IR-6 Centrifuges Nothing New

Caretaker of Iran's mission at the International Atomic Energy Agency Mohammad Reza Qa'ebi said that the IAEA's report on Iran's use of advanced centrifuges to produce enriched uranium is nothing new, adding that the country's

nuclear installations are under supervision of the UN nuclear watchdog. A new report by the International Atomic Energy Agency said that Iran has started producing enriched uranium with more efficient home-made advanced IR-6 centrifuges at its Fordow plant. Qa'ebi said that the report is nothing new and is "a routine technical updated report". He added that Iran had informed the Agency before taking the actions as usual, and the IAEA, in turn has informed its members about them on a regular basis. The Iranian diplomat added that "according to the IAEA report, Iran has started injecting gas into IR-6 centrifuges at Fordow to produce 20% enriched uranium hexafluoride". He added that "Iran has allowed the IAEA to increase verification at the site".

## Vienna talks proceeding with sanctions removal priority: Iranian FM

### IAEA chief: There is no 90% enrichment in Iran

Director-General of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Rafael Grossi has said that there is no 90% enrichment at the moment in the Islamic Republic of Iran. The IAEA is not a party to the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action aka JCPOA, he said, adding that as an inspector and guarantor of the agreement, the Agency closely monitors the ongoing negotiations in Vienna. The JCPOA had set a limit of 3.67 percent for enrichment, but now 60 percent enrichment is being done, he pointed out. Iran is enriching at 20 percent at Fordow Fuel Enrichment Plant and is increasing it, he added.

### Blinken says nuclear talks halted because Iran 'doesn't seem serious'

United States Secretary of State Antony Blinken said Friday that this week's round of negotiations between world powers and Iran in Vienna was halted because Tehran does not seem to be serious about reaching an agreement with the US that would see a joint return to compliance with the nuclear agreement. "What we've seen in the last couple of days is that Iran right now does not seem to be serious about doing what's necessary to return to compliance, which is why we ended this round of talks in Vienna," Blinken told Reuters. secretary of state said the US would now consult with its allies, including Israel, on how best to move forward. "And we will see if Iran has any interest in engaging seriously, but the window is very, very tight."

## French president: Difficult to reach nuclear deal if Gulf, Israel not involved

#### Iran Tests Defense System above Natanz

Iran's Air Defense Force announced that it has fired missiles on Saturday night to test rapid reaction forces above the city of Natanz in the Central parts of the country. The statement came after reports of a large explosion that was heard in Natanz. Natanz

air defense commander confirmed the report about the test fire of the missiles in the sky above Natanz, where a nuclear site is located, but emphasized that there is nothing to worry about. The commander added that such exercises are carried out in a completely safe zone in full coordination with the integrated air defense network to assess the systems located in the area.

No damage was reported, according to initial investigations, the commander noted. Meanwhile, an informed local source said that the blast in the desert area of Natanz city has nothing to do with nuclear facilities and caused no damage.

The unnamed source said the missile was fired in a safe zone 20km from Natanz to test air defense.

### **IRGC Seizes Illegal Weapons Shipment** in Northwestern Iran

## Iraq exempted from US sanctions on Iran gas, electricity

### No evidence Iran has decided to weaponize nuclear program, CIA chief says

The head of the Central Intelligence Agency said Monday that the United States does not have evidence that Iran has made a decision to weaponize its nuclear program. The US spy agency "doesn't see any evidence that Iran's Supreme Leader [Ali Khamenei] has made a decision to move to weaponize," CIA Director William Burns told the Wall Street Journal's annual CEO Council, according to CBS News. Burns said Monday that "the Iranians have not been taking the negotiation seriously at this point," before adding, "we'll see soon enough about how serious they are."

### Iranian FM Dismisses 90%-Degree Enrichment of Uranium

writing is fully in keeping with the Iran nuclear deal, JCPOA, and there is nothing in the documents beyond the agreement nor does the text contain any demands beyond the JCPOA," he said.

### Iran says nuclear talks to restart, as France calls its draft proposals unreasonable

Proposals submitted by Iran at talks in Vienna last week aimed at reviving the 2015 nuclear deal fall well short of what is needed, France said on Tuesday, adding that time was running out with Iran's atomic drive making worrying progress. "The proposals presented by Iran last week do not constitute a reasonable basis that is compatible with the objective of a rapid conclusion while respecting the interests of all," the French foreign ministry said in a statement. It expressed "disappointment" that the talks failed to move forwards, after diplomats agreed on Friday to pause the discussions for several days to allow consultations in capitals.

## US hits Iran with new sanctions over rights abuses as nuclear talks flounder

The United States slapped fresh sanctions on a dozen Iranian officials and entities for "serious" human rights abuses Tuesday, days after nuclear talks with Tehran halted with no sign of progress. The sanctions announced by the US Treasury and State Department targeted government officials and organizations involved in the repression of protesters and political

activists, and prisons where activists have been held in brutal conditions. The Treasury also placed several Syrian officials on its sanctions blacklist for their roles in political repression and chemical gas attacks, and Uganda's military intelligence chief was hit with sanctions for extreme abuse of people arrested for their nationality or political beliefs.

## Intensifying bans will fail to create leverage on Iran amid Vienna talks, Tehran tells U.S.

## Iran preps space flight amid increasing tensions with Israel, US over nuclear talks

Iran appears to be preparing for a space launch as negotiations continue in Vienna over its tattered nuclear deal with world powers, according to an expert and satellite images. The likely blast off at Iran's Imam Khomeini Spaceport comes as Iranian state media has offered a list of upcoming planned satellite launches in the works for the Islamic Republic's civilian space program, which has been beset by a series of failed launches. Iran's paramilitary Revolutionary Guard runs its own parallel program that successfully put a satellite into orbit last year. Iran's foray into space comes at a precarious time for the Islamic Republic, with Israel and the United States considering secondary options in case talks fail, discussing possible military drills in order to practice destroying Iranian nuclear facilities in a potential worst-case scenario. Israel already believes that Iran is ratcheting up its forces into order to attack neighboring nations.

### Iraqi F-16 air strike kills 6 terrorists in Anbar desert

The Security Media Cell announced on Monday, that 6 terrorists were killed in an air strike by Iraqi F-16 warplanes in Anbar desert. "With a qualitative operation, Joint Targeting Cell for the Joint Operations Command detected a den of Daesh terrorist gangs north of the 160 kilometer area in Anbar desert, by means of a reconnaissance plane of the International Coalition and instructed the Air Force Command to carry out an aircraft strike by Iraqi F-16s," according to a statement by Security Media Cell, received by the Iraqi News Agency (INA).

### US Senate votes to allow military sale to Saudi Arabia

### 'Turkish defense industry exported 228 products to 170 countries'

### US approves \$9.4 billion military sale to Greece

The U.S. State Department approved the sale of four warships worth \$6.9 billion to Greece on Friday along with the existing frigate modernization transactions worth

The agency underlined that the acquisitions will "enhance stability and maritime security" in the Eastern Mediterranean region and contribute to the security and strategic objectives of NATO and the US.

### Ukraine, Turkey to jointly produce newgen armed drones

## Greece seeks to add 15 warships to inventory in 5 years: Report

Greece is carrying out an ambitious rearmament program for its armed forces, with a report by local Kathimerini newspaper confirming that it seeks to add 15 warships to its inventory in the next five years. In a story on Tuesday, the daily said that as a first step, a contract for the purchase of three French FDI-type frigates will be completed soon. The government will then make a final decision of corvette purchase program, for which Dutch, Italian and French companies are competing. Meanwhile, Greek and US coast guards signed a cooperation memorandum in Athens on Tuesday, the official AMNA news agency reported. The agreement that came amid expanding US-Greek military cooperation was inked in the presence of Shipping Minister Greek Giannis Plakiotakis and US Ambassador Geoffrey Pyatt. Turkey has often warned Greece against indulging in an arms race, offering instead to resolve all outstanding issues, including in the Aegean, Eastern Mediterranean, and Cyprus, through dialogue.

## UAE buys record 80 French Rafale jets in \$19bn arms deal

The United Arab Emirates and France have signed a \$19bn arms deal that will see the Gulf state acquire 80 Rafale fighter jets and 12 military helicopters. The largest-ever overseas sale of Rafale jets was sealed on Friday as French President Emmanuel Macron began a two-day trip to the Gulf,

during which he will also visit Qatar and Saudi Arabia. "This contract cements a strategic partnership that is stronger than ever and directly contributes to regional stability," the French presidency said in a statement after Macron and Abu Dhabi Crown Prince Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed Al Nahyan (MBZ) signed the deal on the sidelines of the Dubai Expo 2020. Macron's visit comes at a time when Gulf Arab states have voiced uncertainty about the United States's focus on the region even as they seek more weapons from their key security ally.

### French fighter jets not a substitute for American F-35s: UAE

The Gulf Arab state on Friday ordered 80 Rafale fighter jets made by Dassault Aviation and 12 Caracal military helicopters manufactured Airbus by Helicopters in an arms contract worth 17 billion euros (\$19.2 billion). Major Gen. Ibrahim Nasser Al Alawi, commander of the UAE Air Force and Air Defense, said in a statement on state news agency WAM late on Saturday that the Rafale jets would replace the UAE's French-built Mirage 2000 fleet. "This deal is not considered as an alternative for the forthcoming F-35 deal, it is rather a complementary deal ... as we develop our air force capabilities," Alawi said and added that the UAE had for some time been looking to replace its Mirage fleet.

### US ready to proceed with F-35 sale after UAE's withdrawal threat

The United States is ready to move forward with the sale of F-35 fighter jets and drones to the United Arab Emirates (UAE), its top diplomat said Wednesday, a day after Abu Dhabi told Washington it would suspend talks on the \$23 billion deal that also includes munitions. "The UAE informed the U.S. that it will suspend discussions to acquire the F-35," a UAE official told Reuters on Tuesday, citing requirements, "technical operational restrictions, and cost/benefit analysis" for the re-assessment. In Kuala Lumpur on Wednesday, U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken said Washington had to conduct some reviews but was prepared to move forward with the sale. "We've wanted to make sure, for example, that our commitment to Israel's qualitative military edge is assured, so we wanted to make sure that we could do a thorough review of any technologies that are sold or transferred to other partners in the region, including the UAE," Blinken said. The UAE had signed a deal to purchase 50 F-35 stealthy jets made by Lockheed Martin, up to 18 MO-9B drones and other advanced munitions, sources told Reuters in January.
