Iran Rejects IAEA's Access to Memory Cards of Cameras at Karaj Facility

Spokesman of the Atomic Energy Organization of Iran (AEOI) Behrouz Kamalvandi confirmed on Thursday his country's agreement with the International Atomic Energy Agency on installation of cameras at TESA Karaj complex, but meantime, said that the IAEA will not have access to the cameras' memory cards. Kamalvandi said the installation will be made as AEOI and IAEA officials have exchanged views on removing concerns over the possibility of using the cameras by saboteurs. The official went on to say that the cameras could not be opened without IAEA's agreement. So, the two sides agreed to give one camera to Iran for accurate technical review, he said, adding that the IAEA technical experts will answer technical questions being asked by Iranian security officials about the cameras.

Iran flatly rejects statement by Persian Gulf Arab leaders as 'unconstructive'

The group's leaders, who had gathered for an annual summit in Riyadh on Tuesday, repeated claims concerning the Islamic Republic's nuclear energy work, defensive missile program, and regional clout. According to Press TV,

Khatibzadeh roundly rejected the allegations, considering them to be "continuation of the unconstructive and wrong attitude that is held by some of the Council's members."

AEOI Head: Iran, IAEA Agreement to Foil Enemies' Plots

Head of the Atomic Energy Organization of Iran (AEOI) Mohammad Eslami said on Thursday that the recent agreement between Tehran and the UN nuclear watchdog about TESA Karaj complex will thwart the ill-wishers' plots and help the Iranian negotiators. "Ill-wishers of the Iranian nation and the Zionists regularly resort to psychological warfare to claim that the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is not aware of Iran's activities," Eslami told reporters. The AEOI seeks to neutralize such moves and foil the plots of the enemy so that the Iranian negotiating team in Vienna talks can reach their goal which is the removal of sanctions, he added. Eslami referred to his recent meeting with Director-General of the IAEA Rafael Grossi, and said that previously, four issues related to the Karaj site had remained unresolved.

Iran: IAEA Camera's Storage Device Destroyed in Sabotage Attack against Karaj Facility

Iran announced that the memory card of the camera installed at TESA Karaj complex was destroyed during the June sabotage attack against the facility, dismissing the UN nuclear watchdog's claims. Director-General of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) Rafael Grossi showed the camera system similar to those used in an Iranian centrifuge-parts workshop at Karaj at a press conference in Vienna on Friday. He claimed that critical footage from a surveillance camera at the facility had gone missing, though acknowledging that the camera, one of the four IAEA cameras placed at the facility, "had destroyed" in a sabotage attack in June. Iran removed the cameras, along with the destroyed one, and showed them to the nuclear watchdog inspectors. However, Grossi on Friday asked for the so-called missing memory card of the destroyed camera.

Iranian and Chinese FMs discuss Vienna negotiations and ties

He supported positions of Iran, stressing the need for convergence and cooperation with other developing countries against unilateralism on the part of certain Western countries, particularly the United States.

Spokesman: IAEA to Reinstall Cameras at Iran's Karaj Facility Soon

Spokesman of the Atomic Energy Organization of Iran (AEOI) Behrouz Kamalvandi said on Sunday that the UN nuclear watchdog will reinstall cameras at TESA Karaj complex in the next few days after meeting Tehran's conditions. "Today, meetings between the technical and security officials of the AEOI and the inspectors and technicians related to the International Atomic Energy (IAEA) cameras are being held at the AEOI building (in Tehran)." Kamalvandi told FNA. He noted that Iran was suspicions that the IAEA cameras might have been used by enemies for the recent sabotage act at Karai facilities and therefore, after negotiations and writings with the IAEA, the Agency accepted to provide us with a sample camera to answer to the questions of the Iranian technical experts. "Since the preconditions set by our country, including condemnation of the sabotage act in Karaj facilities (by the IAEA) and cooperation in the field of technical investigations about the possible role of the cameras in this incident has been accepted by the IAEA and are being implemented, the Agency's cameras will be installed in the TESA complex in Karaj probably in the next few days," Kamalvandi said.

Iran's Precision-Striking Drones Hit Standing, Mobile Targets in Massive Drills

Precision-striking combat drones as well as sophisticated ballistic and cruise missiles played a major role in the large-scale military exercises that Iran's Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) is holding in an area stretching along the Southern shores of Iran on Wednesday. IRGC Ground Force Uses New Homemade Tank in Military Exercise

Iran vows to blow up Israel's Dimona first if war breaks out

Chief of Staff of the Iranian Armed Forces Maj. Gen. Mohammad Bagheri said Israel's key Dimona nuclear facility will be "a prime target" should a war break out between the two archenemies. According to Bagheri, to conduct such an attack at the heart of Israel's Negev Desert, Iran possesses the knowhow and technology to use "multiple routes" and firing options to nullify Israel's advanced anti-missile system, known as the Iron Dome. Bagheri's comments on the "reciprocal" strike were aired from the hard-line state TV Dec. 28, two days after the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) wrapped up a series of large-scale military maneuvers culminating in multiple strikes on a mockup site. IRGClinked media earlier reported that the operation involved 16 missiles five suicide drones that precisely impacted the Israeli "center for the development of weapons of mass destruction."

France slams Iran for satellite launch amid promising nuclear talks

France condemned Friday, Iran's satellite rocket launch, deeming it "all the more regrettable" to have occurred while nuclear talks with world powers were beginning to make progress, echoing the sentiments and concerns of United States and Germany. Iran said on Thursday it had used a satellite launch rocket to send three research devices into space, as indirect U.S.-Iran talks take place in Austria to try to salvage a 2015 nuclear deal. The satellite launch was in breach of United Nations Security Council resolutions, France's foreign ministry said. "These activities are all the more regrettable as they come at a time when we are making progress in the nuclear negotiations in Vienna," the French foreign ministry said.

He stressed, "Any military and security presence inside the US embassy is prevented, and the official Iraqi forces pledge to do so, in addition to the fact that the mutual diplomatic representation between the two countries must be balanced according to the international diplomatic rules."

UK warplane shoots down 'hostile' drone near US base in Syria

British fighter jets shot down a drone approaching al-Tanf base in Syria on Tuesday night, the UK's Defense Ministry said in a statement today. US Central Command and the Pentagon on Thursday both confirmed the incident. Press secretary John Kirby said two unmanned drones were detected entering the 55-kilometer buffer zone surrounding al-Tanf outpost, which houses US special operations troops and Syrian militia fighters on Syria's remote southern border with Iraq and Jordan. Royal Air Force Typhoons on routine patrols in the area were called to investigate, the UK statement read. "As one of these drones infiltrated deeper into the deconfliction zone, it was assessed it was demonstrating a hostile intent," Kirby told reporters today. "It was shot down. The second one was not engaged, and it likely left the area," he said.
