Cyprus opposition slams government for hosting Israeli military drills

The drill simulated various difficulties in a ground assault, such as food, water, and ammunition supply; communication issues; and the general complications in operating in unfamiliar territory.

He also claimed that the IAEA's latest report on Iran's compliance with the JCPOA was indifferent to all the technical answers that Iran had presented, the state news agency IRNA reported.

Israel and Saudi Arabia said in USbrokered talks to improve relations

Israel and Saudi Arabia do not have official diplomatic relations, but covert ties have warmed in recent years, as the Saudi crown prince, Mohammed bin Salman, has increasingly been seeing Israel as a strategic partner in the fight against Iranian influence in the region.
