Iran Carries Out Initial Tests of Bavar 373 Missile System at Range of 300km

Commander of the Iranian Army Air Defense Force Brigadier General Alireza Sabahifard highlighted his country's great advancements in the air defense fields, and confirmed that Tehran has begun conducting initial tests of the domesticallybuilt Bavar 373 missile system at a range of 300 kilometers. Addressing a military academy in the capital Tehran on Sunday, Sabahifard said Iran's Air Defense Force is equipped with indigenous radar systems that can monitor the movements of enemies even in their homes within a span of thousands of kilometers. Iran has upgraded Bavar 373 missile defense system, initially unveiled in August 2019 with a range of 200 kilometers, proportional to threats, the senior commander stated.

Drones Embody an Iran-Russia Alliance Built on Hostility to the U.S.

The Iranian-made drones that Russia sent on Monday to divebomb Ukraine's capital delivered the most emphatic proof yet that Tehran has become a rare, increasingly close ally to the Kremlin, offering both weapons and international support that Russia sorely lacks. There is no deep love between Russia, newly a pariah for attacking another country, and Iran, for decades one of the most strategically isolated nations in the world. But the two authoritarian governments, both chafing under Western sanctions, share a view of the United States as their great enemy and a threat to their grip on power.

IRGC Commander Warns S. Arabia Against Meddling in Iran's Affairs

Commander of the Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) Major General Hossein Salami criticized Saudi Arabia for interfering in Iran's domestic affairs, and urged Riyadh to rein in its anti-Tehran media. The IRGC chief has issued a stern warning against Saudi Arabia over its media campaign that has been stoking tensions in the recent unrest in Iran. "We defend our vital interests under any circumstances. We emphasize that our neighbors should behave non-aggressively according to political logic as well as international and legal law," Maj. Gen. Salami noted on Monday. The senior commander warned Rivadh to stop interfering in Iran's internal affairs through a smear campaign launched by its media, stressing, "I warn the Al Saud regime to control your media or it will backfire on you."

Iran's Military Employs Homegrown Missile Fath 360 During Wargames

The Islamic Revolution Guards Corps (IRGC) Ground Force launched a military exercise in Iran's Northwestern regions in which it used the domestically-developed strategic surface-to-surface missile, Fath (Conquest) 360, with the range of 120 kilometers. The projectile uses tactical solid fuel and is a precision weapon. The missile has a range of 120 kilometers and is capable of destroying a range of targets including logistic systems of the enemy. This enables ground forces to enter the battlefield. Fath 360 is highly resistant to electronic warfare and is capable of destroying its targets without any disruption. Its battery fires its multiple missiles within a minute to avoid getting targeted by the enemy.

Iran backs proposal on nuclear weapons convention

In a United Nations General Assembly meeting on Monday, Heydar-Ali Balouji, a diplomat in Iran's permanent mission in the UN, said that the repeated failures of in revision the Treatv on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (NPT) showed that there was no vision for complete elimination of nuclear arms. Nuclear disarmament has been on the international agenda since 1946 when the General Assembly adopted its first resolution calling for the elimination of nuclear weapons and since the NPT entered into force in 1970, Balouji said. However, the nuclear-weapon he said. states undertook a legal obligation to negotiate to cease the nuclear arms race and disarm. "But the nuclear arsenals have exceeded 13,000 weapons, with the number and quality of these devastative weapons set to increase in the coming years."

Iranian army ground force holds largescale military exercise

The Iranian Army's Ground Force kicked off large-scale three-day drills in West Azarbaijan province to boost its combat capability in the face of new threats. Who is hacking Iran's 'nuclear' server?

Iran thwarted 120 heavy cyberattacks in 20 days: official

"120 heavy DDoS cyberattacks on the infrastructures have been foiled during the past 20 days," he said, according to Tasnim. DDoS, or distributed denial of service, is a type of cyberattack that tries to make a website or network resource unavailable by flooding it with malicious traffic so that it is unable to operate.

At least 13 martyred, over 20 wounded in terror attack in Iran's Shiraz

At least 13 people were martyred and more than 20 others injured in a terrorist attack on a holy shrine in the Southern Iranian city of Shiraz on Wednesday. The assault took place at the Shah Cheragh Shrine on Wednesday evening and was carried out by a heavily-armed assailant. Initial reports said a men armed with Kalashnikov rifle entered the popular Shia shrine at 5:45 pm local time and opened fire at the pilgrims inside the site. One witness told reporters that loud screams were heard in the women's section of the shrine at the time of adhan (the call for prayer) and suddenly an armed man was spotted with a Kalashnikov firing indiscriminately in the compound of the shrine.

Iranian destroyers to be armed with Abu Mahdi cruise missiles

The missile bears the name of the deputy commander of Iraq's Popular Mobilization Units (PMU), who was assassinated in a U.S. drone attack near Baghdad International Airport in January 2020 together with senior Iranian counterterrorism commander Lieutenant General Qassem Soleimani. The missile is being installed aboard Iranian military vessels, according to Irani. He said the opponents are aware of the features and have seen the capabilities of the Abu Mahdi naval cruise missile in action. He revealed that once used in electronic warfare systems, the missile can effectively carry out its missions. The admiral said the missile has gone through multiple testing.

Türkiye's defense spending is projected to post a reel increase in the 2023-2025 period, according to budget documents, and constitute some 2% of the gross domestic product (GDP). While the documents foresee spending of some 1.74% of the GDP by the end of 2022, this figure is expected to decrease to 1.63% and then reach 2% in the two-year period. Türkiye will spend TL 268.6 billion (\$14.4 billion), including foreign aid in 2023, TL 327.5 billion in 2024, and TL 378.1 billion in 2025 for defense. The amount allocated to research and development (R&D) among expenditure items is TL 4.289 billion for 2023.
