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Political Developments

'Former PM of 'AJK' urged UN to take note of persecution of Kashmiris'

The former Prime Minister (PM) of "Azad Kashmir", and currently Member of Legislative Assembly (MLA), Sardar Muhammad Yaqoob Khan has said that the "ongoing oppression of Modi in occupied Kashmir" cannot calm "Kashmiri's spirit of independence." While referring to the removal of Article 370, he said that despite the passage of more than 970 days, the "Indian government has failed miserably to discourage Kashmiris" and stressed that Kashmiris will soon be rewarded for their sacrifices in the "form of freedom." He said that peace in South Asia is not possible without resolving the Kashmir issue, and added that the "genocide of women, children, the elderly, especially the youth, are being carried out." He urged the United Nations (UN) to take note of the "persecution of Kashmiris", who "continued their struggle" till the attainment of their basic right, right to self-determination.

'APHC-AJK concerned about the plight of IIOJK detainees in jails'

The All Parties Hurriyat Conference "Azad Jammu and Kashmir" (APHC-AJK) chapter has expressed their "concern over the plight of illegally

detained leaders and activists of the resistance movement of Kashmir," languishing in jails and interrogation centres of India and within the "occupied territory of Jammu and Kashmir." The 'APHC-AJK' leaders, while referring to the "ailing illegally detained leaders" noted that despite the deteriorating health conditions of the prisoners belonging to the "resistance movement of Kashmir," the "fascist jail authorities" have turned a deaf ear to the "genuine demands" of the prisoners to provide them medical treatment and basic amenities as per jail manual, added that it is a "brazen violation of the prisoners' rights" as guaranteed by the Human Rights Charter of 1948. The APHC- 'AJK' leaders said that the APHC chairman Masarrat Aalam Butt, Shabbir Ahmad Shah, Ghulam Ahmed Gulzar, Muhammad Yasin Malik, Dr Mohammad Qasim Fakhtoo, Asiya Andrabi, among others are suffering from "multiple ailments", without the availability of basic facilities in jails.

'GB CM is accused of submitting fake degrees'

The Chief Minister (CM) of Gilgit-Baltistan (GB) has been accused of submitting an "allegedly fake degree" to get membership in the Bar Council. The CM spokesman, Imtiaz Ali Taj has vehemently condemned the "baseless and fabricated report." The CM has also said that it will launch a defamation case against the newspaper and the reporter, Shabbir Mir of GB. The report

first emerged after the opposition leader in GB assembly, Amjad Husain of Pakistan People's Party (PPP), noted that the CM law degree was fake and obtained illegally, added that The Express Tribune story by Shabbir Mir, also included images of a degree allegedly issued by a "Belford University" to the CM. After rebuttals from the GB CM office, the reporter Shabbir Mir has said that he stood by his story, stressed that he has all the "evidence, proofs and witnesses present and alive" to confirm his story."

'AJK' President to visit OIC headquarters at Jeddah

The president of "Azad Jammu and Kashmir" (AJK), Barrister Sultan Mehmood Chaudhary will pay his first-ever visit to the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) headquarters at Jeddah this month at the invitation of the OIC. During his 04-day visit to Saudi Arabia, Barrister Chaudhry is scheduled to meet the OIC secretary-general, Hussain Brahim Taha and other officials. The president besides apprising the OIC chief of the "prevailing political and human rights" situation in the "Indian occupied Kashmir" would also have meetings with Saudi officials and members of the Kashmiri community settled in Saudi Arabia. The president would also visit the Holy Shrine of the Prophet (SAW) in Madinah after performing Umrah in Makkah. It may be noted that the

formal invitation to the 'AJK' president to visit the OIC headquarters was extended by the OIC officials during their foreign ministers' conference in Islamabad last month.

'A no-confidence motion will soon be held in AJK and GB: 'AJK' assembly opposition Leader

The Leader of Opposition (LoP), in the legislative assembly of "Azad Kashmir", Chaudhry Latif Akbar hosted the Iftar dinner in the honor of chief editors and various members of the legislative assembly of "Azad Kashmir" and the additional secretary-general of Pakistan People's Party (PPP). He discussed the latest political situation in the country including "Azad Kashmir" with them. 'AJK' President urges Kashmiri expatriates in Jeddah to expose India's hegemonic designs in 'IoK'

While highlighting the Bharatiya Janta Party (BJP) government's "hegemonic designs" in the "Indian occupied Jammu and Kashmir" (IOJK), the 'AJK' president Barrister Sultan Mahmood Chaudhry has that the "apartheid regime" led by Modi was hell-bent on to "grab Kashmir by hook or by crook." determination". The 'AJK' president was accorded a warm welcome at the Jeddah airport and a large number of Kashmiris settled in Saudi Arabia were present at the airport to receive him. The locals played the poems eulogizing the sacrifices of Chinese and Pakistani workers who laid their lives in the construction. The locals noted that around fifty-four Chinese are buried in the cemetery; every year on April 4, we pay tribute to the Chinese workers and engineers at China Yadgar,” adding that “China and Pakistan’s friendship is a perfect example of one soul and two bodies. We are together at grief and happiness.” It has also been said that due to China’s sacrifices, today KKH is linked with China. This road is an integral part of the China-Pakistan Economic Corridor (CPEC).”

Kashmir issue has been unresolved for seven decades; UN resolutions have also been passed in this regard: Deputy Speaker of 'AJK' assembly

The deputy speaker of the legislative assembly of "Azad Jammu and Kashmir" (AJK), Chaudhry Riaz Ahmed has said that the "Kashmir issue" has been unresolved for seven decades and many United Nations (UN) resolutions have also been passed in this regard. He said that "India has been continuously violating" these resolutions and Kashmiris are denied their "right to self-determination." He further said that India has also changed the special status of "occupied Kashmir" on August 5, 2019, and has issued "fake domiciles to 4.2 million non-state Hindus to change the composition of the population there," which violates UN resolutions. He noted that the UN Commission on Human Rights had submitted a report on human rights violations in 2018 which mentioned the "widespread human rights violations by India in occupied Kashmir." He further said that the UN should play its role in the release of political leaders and youth in

"occupied Kashmir" who are lodged in various Indian jails.

him and his government, added that Imran Khan's undemocratic way and how he ran away and violated the constitution has been watched by the people.

'Imran Khan meet with the PM of AJK'

He said that anti-Pakistan forces are currently active and, in such circumstances, the opposition parties have to show responsibility. He emphasized that at present all parties have to move towards a new public mandate to find the solution to all problems, added that PM Imran Khan showed greatness by announcing elections. He stressed that

the external forces want to destabilize Pakistan and therefore the opposition parties should think about who they want to please in this situation. He said that until yesterday, the opposition parties were demanding elections and today they are running away from the elections. Is the opposition running away from defeat or does it want to please someone else? He said that the PM Imran Khan has the full support of the people of Pakistan and Kashmir and he will return to the government with a two-thirds majority.
