DAC Clears Capital Acquisition Proposals Worth over Rs 54,000 Crore

The Defence Acquisition Council (DAC) on 20 March 2025 <u>accorded</u> Acceptance of Necessity (AoNs) to eight capital acquisition proposals amounting to over Rs 54,000 crore. This includes procurement of 1350 HP Engine for the Army, Varunastra Torpedoes (Combat) for the Navy and Airborne Early Warning & Control (AEW&C) Aircraft Systems for the Airforce.

MoD Signs Contract for T-72 Tanks for Indian Army

The MoD <u>signed</u> a contract with. Rosoboronexport (RoE), Russian Federation on 7 March 2025 worth \$ 248 million for procurement of 1000 HP Engines for T-72 Tanks in fully formed, completely knocked down and semi knocked down conditions.

Contract Signed with BEL for Low-level Transportable Radar for IAF

The Mod <u>inked</u> a capital acquisition contract with BEL, Ghaziabad on 12 March 2025 for the procurement of Low-level Transportable Radar, LLTR (Ashwini) at a cost of Rs 2,906 crore.

MoD Brainstorms with 50 MSMEs and Start-Ups

Senior officials of Department of Defence Production, under the chairmanship of Secretary (DP) Sanjeev Kumar, <u>held</u> deliberations with over 50 start-ups and MSMEs on understanding the key challenges affecting these ventures in New Delhi on 24-25 March 2025.

MoD Inks Contracts for ATAGS

The MoD <u>signed</u> contracts with Bharat Forge Limited and Tata Advanced System Limited on 26 March 2025 for the procurement of 155mm/52 Calibre Advanced Towed Artillery Gun Systems (ATAGS) and High Mobility Vehicle 6x6 Gun Towing Vehicles respectively at a total cost of about Rs 6,900 crore.

MoD Inks Rs 2,500 Crore Contracts for NAMIS

The MoD <u>signed</u> a contract on 27 March 2025 with Armoured Vehicle Nigam Limited for the procurement of Nag Missile System (NAMIS) Tracked version of anti-tank weapon platform and Force

Motors Ltd & Mahindra & Mahindra Ltd for around 5,000 Light Vehicles for the Armed Forces at a total cost of around Rs 2,500 crore.

MoD Inks Contracts for Supply of 156 LCH, Prachand

The MoD on 28 March 2025 <u>signed</u> two contracts with HAL for supply of 156 Light Combat Helicopters (LCH), Prachand, along with training and other associated equipment worth Rs. 62,700 crore, excluding taxes. The first contract is for supply of 66 LCHs to the Indian Air Force (IAF) and second is for supply of 90 LCHs to the Indian Army.

DRDO and Indian Navy Successfully Flight-Test Indigenous VL-SR-SAM

The DRDO and the Indian Navy <u>conducted</u> the successful flight-test of indigenously-developed Vertically-Launched Short-Range Surface-to-Air Missile (VLSRSAM) off the coast of Odisha on 26 March 2025.

DRDO Conducts LCA Tejas Integrated Life Support System

The Defence Bio-Engineering & Electro Medical Laboratory (DEBEL), a Bengaluru-based lab under the DRDO, successfully conducted high-altitude trials of the Indigenous On-Board Oxygen Generating System (OBOGS)-based Integrated Life Support System (ILSS) for the LCA Tejas aircraft, on 4 March 2025.

First Rear Fuselage for LCA Mk1A Handed Over to HAL

The first rear fuselage for Light Combat Aircraft Mk1A, produced by Indian private industry, Alpha Tocol Engineering Services Private Ltd, was <u>handed</u> over to HAL in the presence of Raksha Mantri Rajnath Singh in Bengaluru, on 9 March 2025.

Tejas LCA AF MK1 Test-Fires Beyond Visual Range Air-to-Air Missile

The Aeronautical Development Agency (ADA) successfully <u>conducted</u> test-launch of home grown ASTRA, Beyond Visual Range Air-to-Air Missile (BVRAAM) from LCA AF MK1 prototype fighter aircraft on 12 March 2025.

Eighth Missile cum Ammunition (MCA) Barge Delivered

The induction ceremony of the eighth Missile Cum Ammunition Barge (MCA) Barge, LSAM 11(Yard 79) was <u>held</u> on 7 March 2025 at Naval Dockyard, Mumbai. With delivery of LSAM 11, the shipyard completed contractual delivery of all eight Barges to Indian Navy.

Yard 133 (LSAM 23) Delivered

The induction ceremony of ninth Ammunition Cum Torpedo Cum Missile (ACTCM) Barge, LSAM 23 (Yard 133) was <u>held</u> on 12 March 2025 at Naval Dockyard, Mumbai.

Goa Shipyard Launches Second P1135.6 Frigate

Goa Shipyard Limited successfully <u>launched</u> 'Tavasya', the second frigate of Project 1135.6 (Yard 1259) on 22 March 2025.

DEFENCE DIPLOMACY

Indian Military Launches Operation Brahma to Assist Myanmar

In a swift response to the devastating earthquake that struck Myanmar on 28 March 2025, the Indian Army, under 'Operation Brahma', <u>deployed</u> a specialised medical task force to provide urgent humanitarian assistance. Indian Navy ships *Satpura* and *Savitri*, from the Eastern Naval Command, <u>sailed</u> for Yangon on 29 March 2025.

India- Kyrgyzstan Joint Special Forces Exercise KHANJAR-XII Held

The 12th edition of the India-Kyrgyzstan Joint Special Forces Exercise KHANJAR-XII took place in Kyrgyzstan from 10-23 March March 2025.

BONGOSAGAR 25 and Indian Navy-Bangladesh Navy CORPAT Held

The India-Bangladesh Naval Exercise Bongosagar 2025 and Coordinated Patrol was <u>conducted</u> in Bay of Bengal in the second week of March.

23rd Edition of VARUNA 2025 Held

The 23rd edition of the naval exercise with France *VARUNA*, took place from 19 to 22 March 2025. Aircraft carriers Vikrant and Charles de Gaulle, alongside their fighter aircraft, destroyers, frigates, and an Indian Scorpene-class submarine participated in the exercises.

Indian Navy's First Training Squadron Visits Thailand

As part of the ongoing training deployment of the First Training Squadron (1TS) to

South East Asia, INS Shardul, INS Sujata and ICGS Veera <u>arrived</u> at Phuket Deep Sea Port, Thailand on 1 March 2025.

Indian Naval Ship Kuthar Visits Colombo

INS Kuthar, Eastern Fleet Ship under the aegis of Eastern Naval Command was on mission deployment in Indian Ocean Region and <u>visited</u> Colombo, Sri Lanka on 4 March 2025.

INS IMPHAL Participates in Mauritius National Day Celebrations

Indian Naval Ship Imphal <u>made</u> her maiden port call at Port Louis, the capital

city of Mauritius, on 10 March 2025. The ship participated in the 57th Mauritius National Day celebrations on 12 March 2025.

ICGS Saksham Makes Port Call at Port Victoria, Seychelles

Indian Coast Guard (ICG) Offshore Patrol Vessel Saksham <u>made</u> a port call at Port Victoria, Seychelles, on 12 March 2025 and at Antsiranana, Madagascar on 18 March 2025 as part of its overseas deployment to friendly countries in the Indian Ocean Region.
