

SUBJECT: SPECIAL REPAIR WORK OF FOOT OVER BRIDGE CONNECTING TO LIBRARY

Online bids are invited for the work as mentioned above and scope of work and terms & Conditions of the order shall be as follows: -

- 1. **Time Schedule:** The work shall be completed within 60 days from the date of award. A sum of Rs 500 per day will be charged for delay in completion of work. Assistant Director, decision in this regard shall be final and binding.
- 2. **Execution of Work:** The work shall be executed in best workman like manner, to the entire satisfaction of the Institute.
- 3. **Unit Price:** Unit rates quoted for the work shall be deemed to include for all material, labour, tools and accessories, as required for proper execution of work complete in all respects. Any missing minor details which are not spelt out in the description of items but are required for proper completion of work shall be deemed to have been taken into account in the quoted rates. The rates shall also include for transportation including price escalations, contractor's overheads and profits except GST if any. Nothing extra shall be admissible on any such account.
- 4. **Approval of Material and Workmanship:** The materials which stand rejected shall be removed from the site forthwith and replaced with approved materials at no extra cost.
- 5. **Defect Liability: The** work completed shall have defect liability period of 12 months from the certified date of completion. The contractor shall re-do the work, wherein defects have developed during this period under the direction of the Estate cell, at no extra cost.
- 6 **Completion Of Work:** On completion of the work, the contractor shall inform the Estate cell in writing with the date of physical completion of work for final approval for issue of completion certificate. Inspection of the finished work will be carried out by the representative of MP-IDSA.
- 7. No material will be issued by the department. All materials for the work as per scope of work if required will be procured/arranged by the contractor at his own cost.
- 8. **Submission of Bid:** The technical Bid and the Financial Bid shall have to be submitted online at GeM, tenders will be opened electronically on specified date and time as given in the NIT. All entries in the tender should be entered in online formats without any ambiguity.
- 9. Upon acceptance of the quote, no subletting/transfer would be allowed by the Contractor.

- 10. **Earnest Money Deposit**: Bidders shall deposit Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) along with their bids. While submitting the bid, the vendor shall deposit Earnest Money of **Rs. 19000/** by demand draft "**MP-IDSA**" payable at **New Delhi**. No other mode of remittance shall be accepted. EMD is to remain valid for a period of 90 days beyond the final bid is accepted. EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at the earliest latest on or before the 30th day after the award of the work. The EMD of the successful bidder would be returned, without any interest whatsoever, after the receipt of Performance Security from them as called for in the contract. EMD is not required to be deposited by those Bidders who are registered MSME, etc. The EMD will be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amends, impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the validity period of their tender. The bidders found without EMD are liable for outright rejection.
- 11. <u>Security Deposit</u>: On receipt of the Letter of intent (LOI), the successful bidder shall furnish 5% of the contract value as security deposit in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt from Nationalized Bank or Bank guarantee from Nationalised Bank. The Security deposit shall be valid for a period of fifteen days beyond the defect liability period.
- 12. Payment Terms: Payment will be made on actual measurement basis & 40% payment will be released after delivery of all materials and 60% on satisfactory completion of work. All statutory deductions like TDS, GST as applicable rules shall be made from the due payment of the bidder.

(iii) Contractor is expected to train his labour to carry out the work in peaceful manner without any disturbance to residents.

(iv) The contractor has to make arrangements for cleaning the work site every day and on completion of the work from the work area at his cost.

(v) The contractor shall be paid on the basis of the actual quantity of completed work as per the scope of work.

(vi) Any minor work like applying cement based putty observe during painting required to be completed without any extra cost.

(vii) The work includes crack repair of the wall with specialized chemicals wherever required.

14 Eligibility Criteria: -

- (i) Average Annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31st March of the previous financial year, should be at least Rs. 5 Lakhs per annum.
- ii) Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 3 years ending last day of month previous financial year 2022-23 to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:
 - a. Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.

or

b. Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 75% of the estimated cost.

or

c. One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 100% of the estimated cost.

Note:-Definition of Similar Work: Experience of Civil & Electrical works in any Govt. office or large private sector company.

- 16. **Evaluation & Award of work**: The bids will be evaluated as per the Eligibility criteria given at Clause 14 & 15 above. The bids which are found to be fulfilling the eligibility criteria shall only be considered for opening of Price-Bids. MP-IDSA may seek clarifications in the bids from the bidders during the evaluation process. The work will be awarded to the lowest responsive (L-1), evaluated bidder and Work- order will be issued to the firm. MP-IDSA may like to visit the similar completed works of the successful bidder before considering their bid/ award of work. Substantially responsive financial bids will be checked for any arithmetic errors. Arithmetic errors are to be rectified on the basis of the standard procedure as follows:
 - a) If there is a difference between the amount of rate in figure and in words of an item, and the total amount is worked out, then the rate which corresponds to the amount worked by the bidder shall be taken as correct.

- b) If the bidder has not worked out the amount of an item, or the same does not correspond with the rates written either in figures or in words, then the rate quoted by him in words shall be taken as correct.
- c) If the rate quoted by the bidder in figures and in words tallies, but the amount is not worked our correctly, the rate quoted by the contractor shall be taken as correct and not the amount.

17. Force Majeure:

a) In the event of any unforeseen circumstances directly interfering with the supply of goods/work/service arising during the execution of order such as war, hostilities, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, floods, earthquakes, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts, or acts of God, the Bidder shall, within a week from the commencement thereof, notify the same in writing to the Purchaser with reasonable evidence thereof. Either party shall have the option to terminate the contract on expiry of 90 days of commencement of such force majeure by giving 14 days "notice to the other party in writing. In case of such termination, no damages shall be claimed by either party against the other.

18. Code of Ethics:

a) The Purchaser as well as the Bidder shall observe the highest standard of ethics including laws against fraud and corruption in force in India namely "Prevention of Corruption Act 1988", during the procurement or execution of such contracts. If the bidders are found in Bid pooling or against law against fraud and corruption then their firms may be blacklisted.

19. Dispute Resolution.

- (a) Any dispute and or difference arising out of or relating to this contract will be resolved through joint discussion of the authorities' representatives of the concerned parties. However, if the disputes are not resolved by joint discussions, then the matter will be referred for adjudication to a sole Arbitrator appointed by the Director General MP-IDSA
- (b) The award of the sole Arbitrator shall be final and binding on all the parties. The arbitration proceeding's shall be governed by Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 as amended from time to time.
- (c) The cost of Arbitration shall be borne by the respective parties in equal proportions. During the pendency of the arbitration proceeding and currency of contract, neither party shall be entitled to suspend the work/service to which the dispute relates on account of the arbitration and payment to the contractor shall continue to be made in terms of the contract. Arbitration proceedings will be held at Delhi/New Delhi only.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

- (A) All the T& P is to be arranged by Contractor and nothing extra shall be paid on this account
- (B) The contractor shall make his own arrangement for making electric connections to equipment like drill machine etc. If any.
- (C) The Contractor shall be bound to follow the restrictions on the movement of labour, at MP-IDSA campus due to security or any other reason(s). No Claim shall be entertained on this account.
- (D) The contractor shall be personally responsible for violation of any guidelines and shall have to pay the fine /penalty imposed by appropriate authority. No claim on this account shall be entertained.
- (E) TDS & GST will be deducted as per applicable rules.
- (F) The contractor shall be fully responsible for safe custody of the material even if the materials are under double lock system.
- (G) The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration.
- (H) Pre Bid meeting as per NIT shall be mandatorily. Bidders are adhere to attend the pre bid meeting. If not attending pre bid meeting, bid will not be accepted.
